- Don't answer phone calls from numbers you don't know.
- Utilize a verbal family password. If they don't know the word, hang up!
- If you receive any call for help, hang up. Contact the person directly on a verified means to confirm their identity.
- If you are being asked to wire money, pay with cryptocurrency or buy gift cards, that is an indication of a scam.
