  - Driver #2 stated that after he was turning, vehicle #1 switched lanes from left lane to right striking vehicle #2 on the front left corner with it's front passenger side corner.
  - Driver #2 believed that driver #1 was possibly attempting to get onto eastbound 494 causing the sudden lane change.
  - Driver #1 has an expired instructional permit status and was the only occupant of #1.
  - Driver #1 was cited for instructional permit violation (no valid driver) and her car was towed due to disabling damage.

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Officers responded to a two car crash at 102 St W / Nicollet Av S. Upon arrival officers spoke to both drivers and both were not injured. The driver of VEH 1 stated she was driving N/B on Nicollet towards 102 St when she stopped at the four way intersection that was controlled by stop signs. The driver of VEH 1 claimed that there no vehicles incoming so she proceeded and that is when she struck VEH 2, who was driving E/B on 102 St from Nicollet. The driver of VEH 1 stated she did not see VEH 2 and did not know where it came from. There was moderate front end damage to VEH 1, however it was still operable.

The driver of VEH 2 stated that she was driving E/B on 102 St towards Nicollet Av when she stopped for the four way intersection. She claimed that she arrived at the intersection first and came to a complete stop. When she proceeded forward, VEH 1 ended up driving N/B as well and collided into the passenger side of her vehicle. The collision caused VEH 2 to continue southeast through the intersection and ultimately she collided into the Grace Covenant Church sign that was at the southeast corner of 102 St / Nicollet. I observed that VEH 2 had severe damage to the passenger side as well as the front right quarter panel. The vehicle was undriveable and had to be towed by Chief's towing.

I also observed that the Grace Covenant church sign was completely knocked over and there were multiple damaged bricks underneath the sign. I attempted to reach the owner of the Church, but was unable to. A voice mail was left with the church advising them of the case number and damage.

Both drivers had valid DL and insurance. Both were advised and given the case number for the state crash report. Photos were taken on scene of the damage and uploaded to EVIDENCE.com.

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## Opening Statement

On 03/14/2024 at 0805 hours, Officers were dispatched to a road rage incident involving a crash on East Old Shakopee Road (WB) just east of Old Cedar Av.

## Officer Actions/Observations

Upon arrival, Officers met with both parties.

Veh 1: MN Lic NLJ376 2011 Infiniti M37, Driven by Gasimov, Haji Natig DOB 10/26/1973

Veh 2: MN Lic DCP514 2013 Honda Ridgeline, Driven by McPherson, Scott Lueth DOB 11/19/1996

Both vehicles had crashed into each other and were stopped on Old Shakopee Rd just east of Old Cedar Av in the westbound lanes.

I met with an independent witness at the scene, identified as Paula Peterson DOB 11/11/1972. Peterson stated she was traveling in front of both vehicles when they got on to Old Shakopee Rd from NB Hwy 77. She stated she saw Veh 1 driving crazy on the driver side of Veh 2. Veh 1 hit the side of Veh 2 purposefully and sent Veh 2 into the grass and crashed through a road sign. She stated neither party got out of the vehicle once they crashed.

Based on the initial information from the witness, Veh 1 driver, Gasimov, was arrested for criminal damage to property and booked at the Bloomington Police Department.

Veh 2 driver, McPherson, stated that Veh 1 crashed into him on purpose.

Officer Merseth obtained MN DOT Traffic camera footage and I saw the following.

Both vehicles were NB Hwy 77 crossing the river. Veh 1 was in the far right lane and Veh 2 was in the far left lane. Veh 2 can be seen driving aggressively and was tailgating (following too close) other vehicles. Veh 2 then moved to the far right lane behind Veh 1. The next camera showed both cars exiting to WB Old Shakopee Rd. At the top of the ramp, Veh 2 can be seen tailgating Veh1 and then lane jumps and crosses on the shoulder passing Veh 1. Veh 1 speeds up and then appears to make side contact with Veh 2. Both cars continue westbound out of camera view where the witness then explained the final events before the crash.

Based on this information, Gasimov was released from BPD Jail with a citation (#270124201390) for careless driving.

McPherson was mailed a citation (#270124201391) for Following vehicle too close and Failure to drive within a lane.

A state crash was completed along with a tow sheet for Veh 1.

Both Units were eastbound on Old Shakopee Road approaching the intersection with France Avenue in the left lane. Both drivers stated they were slowing from the red light.

Unit 1 driver said she was braking when she looked back to check on her daughter quickly who was in a rear facing car seat in the back seat. Unit 1 driver said she was traveling less then 5mph when she looked back too late and ran into the back of Unit 2.

Unit 1 driver did not report any injuries and her daughter did not appear to show any signs of distress. Unit 2 driver complained of neck and back pain. Bloomington Fire Department evaluated Unit 2 driver who declined ambulance and decided to have her son transport her to the doctor.

Pictures taken of both vehicles. No visible damage to Unit 1. Very minor damage to Unit 2. Both vehicles able to be driven from the scene.
